

New Puppy Essentials



Food and Water Bowls

Get sturdy bowls that won't tip and are easy to clean. Stainless Steel is a good choice as it won't leach chemicals and is easy to clean and sanitize.

Food made for puppies

Make sure to get food that says on the label that it is specifically made for puppies *or* says it is suitable "For All Life Stages."



Leash and Collar

Puppies can be fragile. For very young puppies, select a flat or martingale collar. Do not use a chain or pinch collar. Choose a regular lead, not a flexi-lead for safer excursions. Remember that you may need to replace the collar a few times as they grow!

Toys

Puppies explore the world through play and their mouths. Give them toys they can play with. Choose some long toys that you can use to entice them away from your clothes and hands!

Enzymatic Cleaner

Puppies can be messy. They have accidents. Choose a pet-safe enzymatic cleaner to help eliminate odor.

Gate/Pen

Keep your puppy and your things safe by blocking access with baby/pet gates and fencing off areas. Do not let young puppies have unsupervised access to stairs.



Grooming Supplies

Puppies get dirty. Look for gentle pet-safe shampoo to use to bathe your pup. It's a great time to start introducing your pup to a brush or comb. Choose the right one for your pup's coat type

Treats and Chews

Start training using small puppy treats. Give them puppy-safe things to chew like Kongs and bully sticks so they have options besides your furniture and your shoes!
